### 2021 NBRC State Economic & Infrastructure Development Investment Program

**Awarded to:** Eastern Maine Development Corporation  
**Project:** EMDC will provide technical assistance for climate resiliency planning, growth strategies for second stage businesses, and access to capital/investments.  
**Location of Project:** Hancock, Penobscot, Piscataquis and Waldo Counties, Maine (CD-02)  
**Grant Amount:** \$ 350,000  
**Total Project Amount:** \$ 455,000

**Awarded to:** Town of Vinalhaven  
**Project:** Vinalhaven's Downtown Project constructs road, sidewalk, crosswalk, parking, boat launch, stormwater drainage, sewer, and water main on .6 mile of Main Street—the island's economic hub, which contributes \$39M/yr in lobster landings and sustains 52 businesses with 200 jobs and \$10M in taxable sales.  
**Location of Project:** Knox County, Maine (CD-01)  
**Grant Amount:** \$ 1,000,000  
**Total Project Amount:** \$ 5,216,160

**Awarded to:** Town of Guilford  
**Project:** This project will enhance existing green space and improve sidewalks, walking paths and signage to develop a walkable downtown. It will also serve to create a robust walkable downtown WiFi network for residents, and will attract tourists.  
**Location of Project:** Piscataquis County, Maine (CD-02)  
**Grant Amount:** \$ 280,000  
**Total Project Amount:** \$ 350,000

**Awarded to:** Town of Pittsfield  
**Project:** Project will reconstruct 4,100' of sidewalk/conduit, replacing 1 electrical control and adding 4,100' broadband fiber to increase and diversify business growth and jobs, leverage private investment, retain and increase talent, and improve working wages by creating a safe & thriving downtown.  
**Location of Project:** Somerset County, Maine (CD-02)  
**Grant Amount:** \$ 245,000  
**Total Project Amount:** \$ 772,426

**Awarded to:** National Digital Equity Center  
**Project:** National Digital Equity Center proposes to continue digital literacy/computer skills learning for approximately 10,000 adult learners throughout Maine to develop workforce skills that will increase employability of participants who will be better qualified.  
**Location of Project:** Androscoggin, Aroostook, Franklin, Hancock, Kennebec, Knox, Oxford, Penobscot, Piscataquis, Somerset, Waldo and Washington Counties, Maine (CD-02)  
**Grant Amount:** \$ 150,000  
**Total Project Amount:** \$ 1,344,275

**Awarded to:** Town of Hermon  
**Project:** The Hammond Street pump station upgrade and Logistics Lane main transmission install will add future increased wastewater capacity for both existing and new industrial properties. The pump station upgrade completely modernizes and right-sizes infrastructure currently at the end of its useful life.  
**Location of Project:** Penobscot County, Maine (CD-02)  
**Grant Amount:** \$ 50,000  
**Total Project Amount:** \$ 1,200,000

**Awarded to:** Greater Augusta Utility District  
**Project:** The project replaces a 900 foot long 8" sewer utility crossing of the Kennebec River with 16" pipe, provides water system looping resiliency with 6,300 feet of 12" and 16" pipe, and increases fiber optic system reliability with 15,000 feet of new fiber cable.  
**Location of Project:** Kennebec County, Maine (CD-01)  
**Grant Amount:** \$ 1,000,000  
**Total Project Amount:** \$ 4,867,225.17

**Awarded to:** Town of Frenchville  
**Project:** The Town of Frenchville is applying for funding to upgrade the existing pump station #2 and replace 3,200 feet of existing 4-inch PVC force main with a 6-inch HDPE force main.  
**Location of Project:** Aroostook County, Maine (CD-02)  
**Grant Amount:** \$ 758,000  
**Total Project Amount:** \$ 1,203,000

**Awarded to:** Loring Development Authority of Maine  
**Project:** Replace 20,000 feet of 60- to 70-year-old sewer pipe and 62 manholes resolving overflows of untreated wastewater and discharge permit violations into the Aroostook River watershed caused by infiltration and inflow at the wastewater treatment plant. This project will also benefit 1,062 sewer users.  
**Location of Project:** Aroostook County, Maine (CD-02)  
**Grant Amount:** \$ 500,000  
**Total Project Amount:** \$ 2,990,000

**Awarded to:** Town of Millinocket  
**Project:** Architectural/engineering design for a new terminal for the municipal airport. There is growing demand for air travel directly to Millinocket and airport improvements are seen as critical to continued economic growth.  
**Location of Project:** Penobscot County, Maine (CD-02)  
**Grant Amount:** \$ 203,439  
**Total Project Amount:** \$ 254,299

**Awarded to:** Town of Danforth  
**Project:** This project funds downtown revitalization efforts: construction of a market pavilion, survey costs, sidewalk repairs, building demolition, and relocation of a playground which will increase Danforth's economic development capacity, foster entrepreneurialism, and support ecological restoration.  
**Location of Project:** Washington County, Maine (CD-02)  
**Grant Amount:** \$ 229,200  
**Total Project Amount:** \$ 286,500

**Awarded to:** Western Foothills Land Trust  
**Project:** The Commons Phase I will improve access to biking and Nordic ski trails, warming hut, and equipment at Roberts Farm Preserve in Norway. It will create 72 parking spaces with 4 networked EV chargers powered by a PV-roofed pavilion for outdoor farmer's market, classes, arts and performances space.  
**Location of Project:** Oxford County, Maine (CD-02)  
**Grant Amount:** \$ 89,842  
**Total Project Amount:** \$ 275,000
