

Certification of Indirect (F&A) Costs

An indirect cost rate is not allowed unless its documentation from a cognizant agency was submitted to NBRC at time of application for federal assistance, indirect costs are reflected in the grantee’s SF424cbw (project budget), and the approved indirect cost rate is referenced in the grantee’s Grant Agreement.

This certificate must be signed on behalf of the grantee by its documented Authorized Official, as reflected in NBRC’s project files and submitted with each request for reimbursement (SF270) that includes indirect costs.
